


Statement of Compliance

This Annual Report is submitted to the Board of Trustees by the Mojave Unified School District Proposition 39 Oversight Committee for Mojave.

The Committee advises that, to the best of its knowledge, the Mojave Unified School District is in compliance with the requirements in Article XIII A, Section 1(b)(3) of the California Constitution. In particular, bond revenue has been expended only for the purposes so described in Measure A. As prohibited by Article XII A, Section 1(b)(3)(a) of the California Constitution, no funds were used for any teacher or administrative salaries or other operating expenses.

Summary of Proceedings and Activities for 2008-2009

On November 4, 2009 the voters of SFID 2 approved a \$14 million bond authorization with a 70.22% vote of approval. On November 18, 2008 the Board of Trustees adopted the Bylaws of the Mojave Unified School District Measure G Citizens' Oversight Committee, appointed committee members, and requested a link be established on the district website. <http://www.mojave.k12.ca.us/prop39/propm/HOME.html> .

On January 29, 2009 the district sold \$6,037,097.70 of the authorized bonds.

On April 22, 2009, the district negotiated a lease-leaseback agreement with Seward L. Schreder Construction, Inc. for modernization projects at Mojave Elementary School and Mojave High School.
